Summary Publication

The Waterville City Council met on May 3, 2022 at its regularly scheduled meeting and passed Ordinance 118, an Ordinance Regulating Vacation by Owner (VRBO) and Short Term Rental Properties. This Ordinance applies to persons renting or leasing property in Waterville for a daily, weekly, or 30 days or less time period. Rentals for more than this time period require a rental license. The Ordinance provides for an annual VRBO license. All licenses expire Dec. 31 of each year and must be renewed annually. All VRBO's require an initial code inspection followed by a code inspection every three years to verify compliance with basic code requirements. The Ordinance regulates occupancy, parking, quiet hours, and prohibited activities. Operating a VRBO without a license is a violation. Violation of the Ordinance is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of up to \$1,000 or incarceration for up to 90 days. Notice of the public hearing was duly noted and duly published in the City's legal newspaper. This is a Summary of Ordinance 118. Ordinance No. 102/22

ESTABLISHING SALARIES FOR THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ELYSIAN LE SUEUR / WASECA COUNTY

WHEREAS, by law under MN Statute 415.11 changes in salary must be approved prior to regular city elections to take effect January in the year following said elections,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Elysian, Le Sueur/Waseca County, Minnesota, as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor shall receive a salary of One Hundred and Seventy Five Dollars (\$175) per month for serving as Mayor and performing all duties associated with the office and Seventy Five (\$75) for each special, emergency, and workshop meeting attended.

Section 2. Each member of the City Council shall receive a salary of One Hundred and Twenty Five Dollars (\$125) per month for serving on the Council and performing all duties associated with the office and Seventy Five Dollars (\$75) for each special, emergency, and workshop meeting attended.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective January 1, 2023, which is the first day of the year subsequent to the next general election.
