Adoption of Ordinance 2022-010

ORDINANCE REQUIRING LANDOWNER OR DESIGNATE TO OBTAIN A PERMIT WHEN SEEKING A BUILDING PERMIT AND/OR SEEKING TO CONSTRUCT AN ACCESS DRIVEWAY OR ENTRANCE.

The Board of Supervisors for the Town of Cedar Lake, Scott County, Minnesota, hereby ordains that on the 2nd day of May 2022, the Cedar Lake Township Board of Supervisors adopted the above Ordinance. Due to the lengthy content of the Ordinance, a brief Summary follows:

- Section 1. Authority.** Identifies the legal authority for the Township to adopt the Ordinance.
- Section 2. Purpose.** Identifies the purpose of the Ordinance.
- Section 3. Definitions.** Defines the terms used in the Ordinance.
- Section 4. Permit Required.** Identifies that a permit from the Township is required for constructing an access driveway or entrance.
- Section 5. Conditions of Permit.** Identifies the conditions of the permit.
- Section 6. Inspection of the work and Fees.** Provides for the inspection of the work and such fees necessary to cover the costs of administration, inspections, mailbox swing away support and install, and to ensure that the work is completed properly.
- Section 7. Indemnification.** Provides for the indemnification of the Township for any negligence on the part of the applicant.
- Section 8. Violation.** Identifies the consequences for violation(s) of this Ordinance.
- Section 9. Separability.** Validity of the Ordinance should a provision be declared invalid.
- Section 10. Effective date.** Identifies the effective date of Ordinance.

The Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately

LANESBURGH TOWNSHIP DUST CONTROL POLICY

Dust Control Guidelines established at the March 8, 2022 Lanesburgh Township Annual Meeting requires residents give a three-day notice prior to applying dust control in order for the road crew to blade and prepare the road surface prior to applying dust coating application. Please contact Liz Krocak, Township Clerk at 952-758-4385. It is the owner's responsibility to mark on home site, the start-to-end area of applied dust coating using either a florescent flag or florescent painted lath. If any time between June 1 to October 1, 2022, the road becomes a safety hazard due to wash out, washboard, or conditions deemed dangerous after road inspection, the township reserves the right to blade the affected road, including the area which was dust coated. Any damage, to dust coating, deemed to be the fault of the township, will be prorated.
